As the rates of poverty, homelessness and adolescent substance use continue to grow in the Dallas community, Rainbow Days' prevention programs and supportive services continue to meet a vital need for our community's most vulnerable children. Since 1982, Rainbow Days has been dedicated to fulfilling its mission of *inspiring children to live a life filled with hope and promise.*

Community Connection – Through the Community Connection program, over 8,500 children and youth, ages 4-17, learn how to make healthy choices, cope with difficult situations, resist negative peer pressure, and make the decision to stay alcohol, tobacco and drug-free.

Family Connection – Through the Family Connection program, over 1,300 children, ages 4-12, and 300 parents – all living in homelessness, domestic violence, or transitional living shelters, learn how to cope with change, manage stress, understand their feelings, protect themselves, make healthy decisions, set goals, and understand how these goals can affect their future.

Our comprehensive services have a lasting impact in children's lives. As a result of being involved in these programs, children learn:

- to recognize their unique value, their strengths and capabilities;
- to identify people they can trust and build healthy relationships with;
- how important it is to treat others with the same respect and kindness they want to be treated with;
- to understand that in order to have a promising future they need to have a healthy mind and body, one that isn't clouded with alcohol, tobacco or other drugs; and
- that they can have a bright and promising future.
